General information about condition of the bid.

Applications for participation must be provided in a sealed A4 envelope addressed to “The Committee Chairman” at the following address: 24 Ibraimov Str., Bishkek, building "Uchkun", 14th floor. The bid process will close at 5pm on May 02th, 2014. Belated applications and applications by email are not accepted. KGC reserves the right to fully or in part, accept, or reject any received application. Only those bids with the most favorable commercial offers and compliance to requested criteria will be considered and contacted by KGC.

Description of the bid.

KGC is launching organic waste segregation program being landfilled in the Kumtor mine site. Therefore, KGC is seeking a reliable contractor to outsource organic domestic and food waste processing services.

Duration of the contract: December 2014

As a minimum, the quote shall include the following:

- Availability of copies of the certificate of registration with the Ministry of Justice, the constituent documents, cards of taxpayer and the taxpayer's registration sheet;
- Availability of copies of all existing licenses and permits related to the process of recycling of organic waste;
- Proposed method should minimise any negative influence to the environment including emission and releasing contaminant, solid waste accumulation and limitation wildlife access.
- Proposed method of recycling should be effectively implemented in severe climate and high altitude conditions;
- Specification for proposed equipment (copy of ownership, renting or partnership documentation and indicate address for inspection of property and equipment). Productive capacity of equipment should be sufficient for process 1- 1, 5 ton of organic waste in day which consisting of:
 - o food leftovers, paper, and wood chips ~ 75%
 - o sewage sludge ~ 25%
- Brief information regarding the largest tenders or businesses dealt with by the bidder in previous two years
- The fixed price offer including all cost (taxes and fees, transportation costs, depreciation and Maintenance of equipment, salary + allowances and bonuses, sick leave, overhead, profit, etc.).
- Proposed method should meet requirements of industrial and environment safety regulations of KR or analogous international requirements;
- A potential contractor should be capable to invest own funds to build / purchase and install necessary equipment which meets all above mentioned criteria;
- A potential contractor should employ trained personnel with necessary qualification, capable to effectively operate and service the equipment to keep it in a good working condition;
- The resulting product should be a biologically stable organic material that can be used as an amendment to soil, to increase its properties for soil reclamation;

KGC obligations:

- Negotiation of volume and dates of removal.
- KGC will provide some of the necessary supplies available onsite, such as electricity and water supply, shipping containers, site etc.;
- KGC will segregate all domestic waste; the existing contracting company will carry out waste collecting and transportation to the waste recycling area;
- Supply camp and food for successful contractor.
